

### **Driving Directions**

#### **To Oxford: 432 CR 312, Ignacio, CO 81137**

From Durango, take Hwy 160 east to Hwy 172 (the airport hwy). Go east on Hwy 172 towards Ignacio. After passing the turnoff for the airport, the Hwy will be straight for a time. It will then take a sweeping curve to the right and then back to the left. Directly after the sweeping left, the highway straightens. Take the next right (south) onto CR 311 (there is a turning lane). This is directly across from the old Oxford Grill. After 100 yards on CR 311, take the first left onto CR 312. Go approximately ¼ mile on 312. The arena will be on the left of the County Road and the roundpen is on the right of the county road. Park between the county road and the large wooden roundpen.

#### **To Florida Mesa: 1766 CR 302, Durango, CO**

From Durango, take Hwy 160 east to Hwy 550 (south) at Farmington Hill. Take Hwy 550 south several miles to CR 301 (the airport connector road). This is a left turn only, and there is grey house at the intersection. Take CR 301 approximately 1 ¼ miles. The farm is on the south (right) side of the CR, and the driveway is on the crest of a hill. You will see a large red hay barn, a smaller red horse barn, and the house is white and sits back in the trees. Be careful to see traffic going both ways before pulling in and out of the driveway!!

#### **To Wilderness Trails Ranch: 23486 CR 501, Bayfield, CO**

From Durango, take Florida Road north to the Durango Bay Store, stay right and cross the Florida River. The county road dead ends at CR 501. Go left or north on CR 501. Below the dam at Vallecito Lake, stay on CR 501, do not cross the dam. Continue around the west, then north, then northeast side of Vallecito Lake on CR 501. On the northeast side of the lake, the road turns from pavement to dirt. The county road turns away from the lake at Elkpoint Lodge and begins to parallel the Pine River up canyon. You will cross two cattle guards. After the cattle guards, you will take the first right (follow signs) onto the driveway. Drop down the hill, do not take the first bridge, but continue on the driveway. You will cross the river and enter the ranch. Follow signs to guest parking.
